

Munster Council GAA Grants

Playing Fields and the provision of Recreational Facilities to cater for all needs of the community young and old are top priorities for all GAA Clubs. The Munster Council gives generous Grants for the purchase and development of GAA grounds, building of dressing rooms, toilets, wheelchair facilities etc..

The Munster GAA Council receives money from Central Council and the Council allocates this to Clubs resulting in sizable grants. In 2007 Munster Council granted a total of €2,411,422 towards field development of both Club and County Grounds. In addition the Council dispersed the Central Council money of €810,000 to Club Development Projects.

The scale of Club grants for 2008 are as follows:

- Purchase 15% of cost to a maximum of €10,000.
- Dressing Rooms 15% of cost to a maximum of €10,000.
- Development 20% of cost to a maximum of €10,000 if sufficient funds are available, otherwise grants will be reduced proportionally.
- Handball Courts (new) €5,000 and refurbishment of Handball Courts €2,500.
- Schools also qualify for appropriate grant aid.

Clubs that are purchasing, building dressing rooms or developing their playing facilities and wish to avail of these grants should contact the County Representative of the Munster Council Development Committee for an application form and any necessary help or advice when completing such forms. Limerick's representative on the Munster Council is Rory Kiely. Your County Development Officer will also provide advice and assistance should you need it.
