

Safety Audit

Every Club should have a *full Safety Audit* completed on their facilities. All matters causing safety concerns should then be put right following the audit. Club personnel can carry out the Audit but it is recommended that a person with a Safety qualification should be asked.

The following are some of the many things that we should look out for.

- Electrics especially those in the shower area of the dressing rooms and in the club hall or bar.
- Removal of all barbed wire from the pitch surrounds. Much of this wire is at eye height and as well as causing nasty facial cuts could also cause damage to or even loss of sight.
- Loose stones on walls especially at entry to the pitch.
- Equipment or objects hidden in the grass before mowing.
- Goal posts and netting are secure in the ground after the winter.
- Portable underage goalposts should be properly anchored at all times and stored in a place where they'll not suffer damage.
- Ensure floor area especially in showers and dressing rooms are non-slip.
- Ensure temporary goalposts are secured properly before use.
